

Inauguration of Bee Home at ICAR-NBAIR Yelahanka campus by Dr T.R. Sharma, DDG (Crop Sciences) and Dr S. C. Dubey, ADG (Plant Protection & Biosafety)

On the occasion of 30th NBAIR institution foundation day, the 'BEE HOME' at ICAR-NBAIR Yelahanka campus was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Dr Tilak Raj Sharma, Deputy Director General (Crop Science), ICAR, New Delhi and Guest of Honour Dr Sunil Chandra Dubey, Assistant Director General (Plant Protection & Biosafety), ICAR, New Delhi. The bee home was housed in the pollinator garden of the campus wherein more than 50 different species of flowering plants were being maintained year-round to ensure pollen and nectar supply for the pollinators. In the Bee Home, artificial structures for cavity nesting leaf cutter bees and ground nesting buzz pollinating bees were being provided. Colonies of stingless bees and honeybees are maintained. During the occasion, ICAR-NBAIR SHATPADA product SAMRUDHA HONEY was also released by the dignitaries.
