

MGMG programme and Khet bachao abhiyan report

The programme was conducted on 08th June 2026 at three villages such as Nidagodi, Yelethotada halli and Kodambahalli in Ramanagara district by ICAR–National Bureau of Agricultural Insect Resources (NBAIR) in collaboration with KVK, UAS Bengaluru, and the State Agriculture Department. A total of 163 farmers actively participated from three villages. Scientists of ICAR-NBAIR highlighted the importance of balanced fertilizer use for maintaining soil fertility and achieving sustainable crop yields. In addition, benefits of bio-fertilizers such as Trichoderma, vermicompost, and farmyard manure was also discussed. Dr. Jagadeesh patil stressed the role of green manuring and crop rotation, particularly the inclusion of pulses to enhance soil nitrogen levels. The programme concluded with an interactive discussion and farmers expressed appreciation for the valuable insights provided.
